

The minutes of the meeting are recorded here.

- 1) Following members could not attend with prior intimation. Therefore, leave of absence was granted to them.
(i) Mr. A. J. Kanhake, (ii) Prof. S. A. Ladhake, and (iii) Mr. Keshav Daga.
- 2) Prof. S.D. Londhe welcomed the external and internal members of the IQAC and informed the agenda of the meeting. Since this is second meeting, the minutes of first meeting were displayed and action taken therein was elucidated to the members. Prof. R.P. Borkar threw the light on the quality initiatives undertaken since the last meeting and other activities like examination and classes being conducted in these difficult times. He has also informed that the exercise of revamping the vision and mission of the Institute is in progress and the new perspective would be adopted soon.
- 3) The status with regard to NAAC, NBA and Autonomy was presented by Prof. S.D. Londhe. It was informed that the applications for all of the above were submitted in February 2020 itself. The autonomy scrutiny committee of SGBAU Amravati University visited the campus on 7th October 2020 and the proposal for extension of autonomy is forwarded to UGC in the last week of October 2020. The expert committee visits for NAAC, NBA and Autonomy are delayed due to pandemic and these are expected from February 2021 onwards.
- 4) Prof. R.P. Borkar asked external members to advise, guide and comment on the activities of the Institute. Prof. Mohd. Atique suggested to conduct the meetings of IQAC at least twice annually as mandatory. Further, he explained the importance of 360 degree feedback as a quality initiative and advised to go for such feedback.

- 5) Dr. N.A. Koli expressed the contentment about the endeavours of the Institute. He promised to help institute along with Prof. Atique for any kind of support needed from SGB Amravati University.
- 6) Prof. S.V. Khond enquired about the status regarding collaborations with industry for improvement in the placement of students. Prof. R.P. Borkar informed that the MoUs to establish two centres of excellence in collaboration with industries are already signed. Information Technology and Instrumentation department has rolled on the work in this regard. Prof. M.M. Deshmukh informed that the placement activity for final year students is already started. He has given detail account of activities with regard to the skill development of students, the online aptitude tests and interviews, the difficulties faced by the students, administration and industry. He iterated that although the job market position is hostile, the efforts are underway for placement of students.
- 7) Prof. R.P. Borkar welcomed the new student member Mr. Pratik Talokar inducted into the cell this year. Mr. Talokar recollected his interaction with the NBA committee experts who visited the campus in October 2018. He expressed that the fine tuning of improvement in the infrastructure, sports and other facilities should be given priority and continuously monitored. Prof. R.P. Borkar suggested him to communicate his observations to the administration on behalf of students.
- 8) Prof. R.P. Borkar sought the comments of internal faculty members and most of the members expressed satisfaction with regard to the activities.
- 9) Prof. R.P. Borkar thanked all the members and sought their enthusiastic support and participation as an IQAC member.
- 10) The meeting ended with the vote of thanks by Prof. S.D. Londhe.
