The collaboration hereunder shall commence from dt. 07.09.2022 and will be valid for one year from the date of commencement.
 - 1.2 Either party shall make available appropriate infrastructure facilities for the Collaboration, which may include general access to the facilities, data content, manuals/ library facilities and other materials as may be required for the various programs to be offered.
 - 1.3 Confidential information shall mean all proprietary information or data furnished by either Party and /or its affiliates before or after the Effective Date hereof, whether written or oral which includes but is not limited to Parties' trade secrets, processes, devices, designs, concepts, improvements, inventions (whether or not patentable or copyrighted), developments, decision technology, specifications, techniques, sketches, applications processes, strategies, designs, photographs, profile of its subsidiaries, branches or details of shareholding, financials, projections, track record, profile of product, and data or information regarding either Parties, employees, prospective employees, business objective /criteria, employee lists, employee profiles, employee information, and other documentation relating to past, present or future business activities and services and which was designated as 'Confidential'.

- Both Parties agrees and confirms that it shall not use, share, and reveal any Confidential Information provided by either Parties for any purpose other than for rendering Services under this MoU.
- 1.4 The Institution agrees to ensure that all personnel from the institution (including students) abide by the applicable MAHAGENCO policies when working on MAHAGENCO premises with regards to Collaboration. The institution agrees to keep MAHAGENCO fully indemnified against any unlawful activity or breach of instructions from MAHAGENCO.
 - 1.5 All or any dispute arising between the parties in respect of the MoU of whatsoever nature shall be resolved under laws of India and any or all such disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Mumbai, India.

1.6 This MoU is not intended to create any relationship in the nature of franchise, joint venture, or agency between the Parties. Neither Party shall act in a manner that expresses or implies a relationship other than that of independent contractors, nor bind the other Party. Either Party or any of its employees/personnel shall not, under any circumstances, be deemed to have any employer-employee relationship with the other Party.

Annexure I

A) Commitments from MAHAGENCO:

B) Commitments from the Institute :

- The deputed Postgraduate/Undergraduate Student will follow the rules & regulations of MAHAGENCO.
- The deputed Postgraduate/Undergraduate Students (Research Assistant should have minimum following eligibility criteria :
 - i) Student has minimum first class in previous academic year.
 - ii) Student should have specialization in Mechanical/Electrical/Instrumentation/Power Engineering/Computer Engineering/Civil Engineering stream.
- The Institute will provide the list of students who are interested in power sector & shall complete the full tenure as 'Research Assistant' & successfully complete the targets given by MAHAGENCO.
- Research assistant shall follow MAHAGENCO Safety rules & regulations to avoid any accidents. In case of any accident/injury to Postgraduate/Under graduate students (Research Assistant) in power plant premises, MAHAGENCO will not be liable for any claim to injury caused to the students.
- If the Research Assistant will not able to complete his tenure due to some issues like health issue/personnel issue & any other issue. The concerned Research Assistant shall refund stipend amount to MAHAGENCO of his attended work period. Recovery & refund of the stipend amount to MAHAGENCO is the sole responsibility of Institute.

- Encourage Students to actively participate in all assigned activities and provide necessary technical skills for them to facilitate career.
- The specific assignment/current problem of power stations /improvements needed/ R&D activity given to the 'Research Assistant' will be analyze & the Research Assistant will suggest new innovative ideas/ improvements & modification required/energy conservation possibilities to improve the plant performance, so that it will be beneficial to MAHAGENCO.

C) General Terms & Conditions of MAHAGENCO for appointment of Research Assistant:-

- The 'Research Assistant' shall be physically fit to work in power plant & produce Medical Certificate of fitness from Registered Medical practitioner at the time of joining.
- The 'Research Assistant' will not get any type of travelling allowance. No any other allowances will be given to them except fixed stipend.
- Permanent employment claim shall not be entertained to Research Assistant.
- The Institute shall indemnify MAHAGENCO from any kind of legal issues during the tenure of Internship.
- The 'Research Assistant' will get required data/parameters from respective power station. The data should remain confidential.
- The PG students will submit Progress Report Monthly & UG students will submit Progress Report fortnightly to C.E. (Training), Koradi Training Centre & Exe. Director (HR), Corp. Office, Mumbai through respective Chief Engineer. Further, the final consolidated report of each Research Assistant from each power Station shall be submitted to Exe. Director (HR), Corp. Office, Mumbai.
- The accommodation facility shall not be provided to Research Assistant.
