




### A TREK WITH ROBO TECH

Ans. The Robo-Tech forum is running from the year 2014 in our college and it was initially founded for this specific competition only, since then it is the main motive of our club to participate in The ROBOCON competition every year.

### Q2) How many team members are there with you?

Ans. Our Over all team cum RTF Family is quite large which includes all the RTF members right from the year of foundation 2013. Talking about this year we have the strength of about more then 30 members from all the years and all the branches of our college.

### Q3) How many days you required to make the bot?

Ans. Criss Jami has rightly said that,


### "Find a purpose to serve, not a lifestyle to live",
