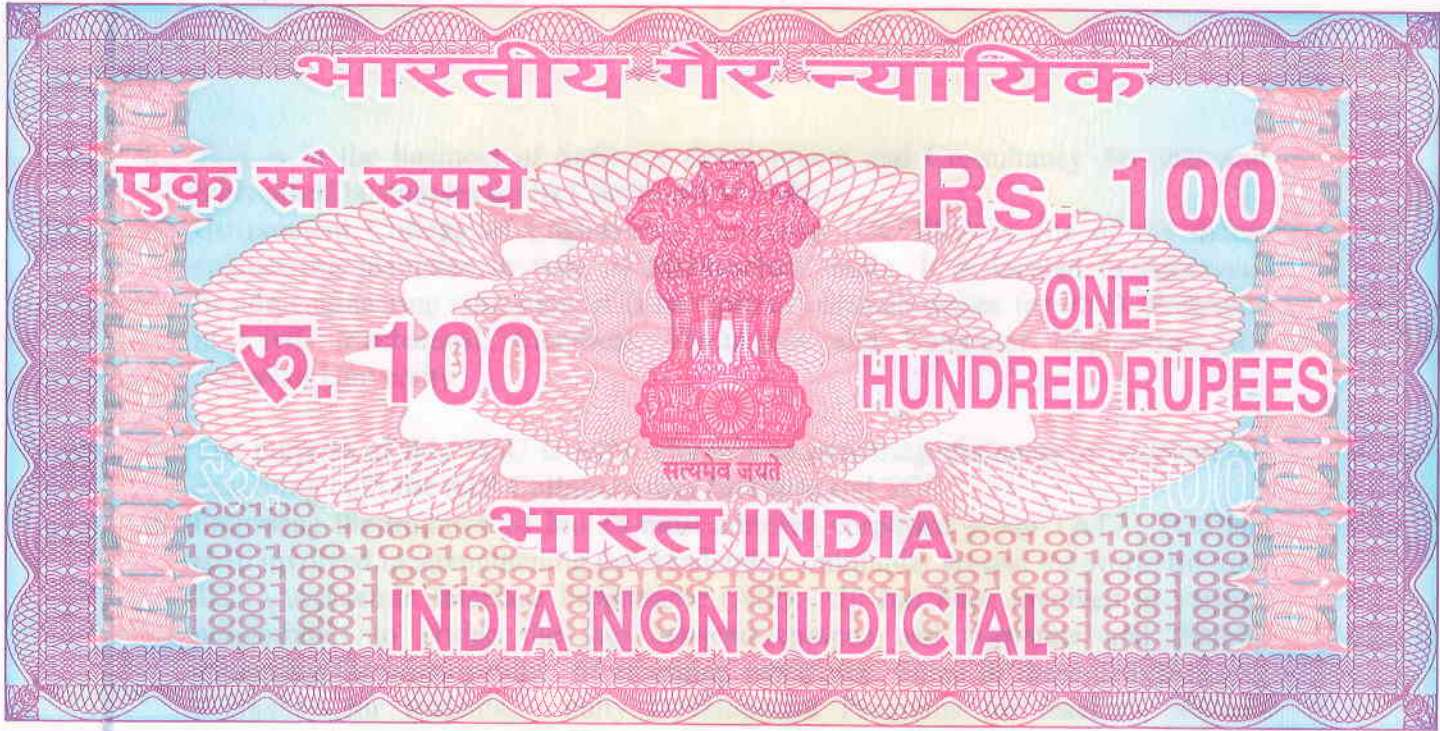

4. **Intellectual Property Rights:** IPR titles or ownership of any products, proprietary information or technology tools, processes, utilities, and methodology including any TCS proprietary products or components thereof used hereunder or development of any deliverables and all new ideas, inventions, innovations, or developments conceived, developed, contributed, distributed or made by TCS hereunder, and all customisations, enhancements and modifications thereof, will not be transferred from TCS to the AIP Collaborating Institute on account of use of the same as part of any work under this MoU and shall always remain with TCS.
5. In no event shall either party be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential damages, including, but not limited to, loss of profits, revenue, data or use, incurred by the other party in connection with, arising out of or under this MoU save for any such loss suffered resulting from any wilful and grossly negligent act or omission of either of the parties.
6. Neither this MoU, nor any activities described herein, shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, agency or other such relationship. Both parties agree that this MoU represents a nonexclusive relationship between the parties and nothing contained herein shall preclude either party from participating/initiating similar relationship with third parties.
7. Neither party shall issue any press release, public announcement or other such disclosure concerning this MoU without the other party's prior written consent as to such release or announcement.
8. This MoU may not be amended without the prior written consent of both the parties.
9. This MoU will be effective for three years from 05-Apr-2016 to 04-April-2019. This MoU can be renewed based on mutual convenience.
10. **Governing Law:** This MoU shall be governed by the laws of India and the Courts in Mumbai shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
11. **Termination:** Either party can cancel or terminate this MoU unilaterally (and without reason), by giving an advance written notice of one month to the other.

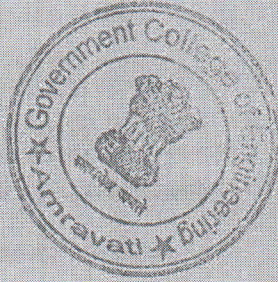

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** is entered into on June 3rd, 2014 and between, the **Government College of Engineering** located in Amravati (hereinafter referred to as **GCOE Amravati**) and the **NESPAL Air Water Heater Pvt Ltd, Aurangabad** (herein referred to as **NESPAL, Aurangabad**).

1. PREAMBLE

Collaborative efforts in engineering education, especially with a live industry interface made available for the students has become the key to success. This has also been identified by TEQIP (Technical Education Quality Improvement Program) project. The TEQIP project encourages institutions to ink MoU's with Industries on viable collaborative / consultancy project with specific time-frames and well-defined outputs. The collaboration could be in the areas of Internships and Industrial Training for students, Student projects, joint sponsored projects from funding agencies, joint consultancy projects with a sound revenue sharing model *etc.* Exploring industry-institute interaction to utilize synergies developed will form the backbone for future survival and relevance of technological institutions.

2. PURPOSE

The aim of this MoU is primarily to establish a written document under which **GCOE Amravati** and **NESPAL, Aurangabad** may enter into a written agreement to perform collaborative programs in the areas of mutual interest.

3. AREA OF COLLABORATION

Some of the major activities to be included in the proposed Memorandum of Understanding are as follows;

1. Summer Training / Internships for pre-final year students from B Tech / M Tech
2. Final Year Projects to Mechanical Engineering students and PG projects for M. Tech (Thermal Engineering)
3. Expert Lectures by **NESPAL, Aurangabad** resource persons
4. Industrial Visits (One per semester)
5. Evaluation of UG & PG dissertations by **NESPAL, Aurangabad** experts
6. Sponsorships for student events like National Technical festival 'Prajwalan'

7. Nomination of **NESPAL, Aurangabad** experts on Board of Studies of Mechanical Engineering for curriculum development and revision
8. Participation in Faculty Development Programs
9. **NESPAL, Aurangabad** experts as faculty in Short term Training Programs.
10. Participation in institute activities like Industry-Institute Partnership Cell and Entrepreneurship Development Cell.

4. AGREEMENT OF COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMMES

- a) Each such collaboration undertaken by them shall describe in details the following:
 - i. The nature, scope and the time of collaborative schedule
 - ii. The form as pursuant to Clause No.3 above
 - iii. Any other provision as deemed to be necessary and agreed by both
- b) To prepare and finalize a concrete action plan and schedule for collaboration on priority areas as agreed upon by both.

5. NODAL AUTHORITY

The Nodal Officer from **GCOE, Amravati** shall be the Principal, GCOE, Amravati or his nominee and the Nodal Officer from **NESPAL, Aurangabad** shall be the Managing Director or his nominee for all decisions making and concurrence.

6. IMPLEMENTATION AND ACTION PLAN

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective from the date of signing the same and shall remain in effect for one year with the possibility of extending the same to subsequent year(s). The Memorandum of Understanding will be reviewed every year subject to satisfactory conduct of activities as covered in clause (3).

In the events or any other unavoidable circumstances, if the MOU conditions are breached, NESPAL Aurangabad shall have the right to cancel or terminate this MOU at any point of time without any prior notice. This right is solely reserved with NESPAL Aurangabad only.

In witness where of, **GCOE, Amravati** and **NESPAL, Aurangabad** hereto have executed this Agreement on the date and the year first herein above written.

7. Intellectual Property Rights and Protection of Patent ownership

During the exchange of knowledge, infrastructure sharing, technical and technological support, financial help, R&D support, and any other relevant support provided by NESPAL Aurangabad for the development and improvement of new and existing technology and product, if any Intellectual Property is developed, the Patents are filed during/after the collaboration period, directly or indirectly connected with the activity/project done, either by an individual or the institution, the ownership shall remain with NESPAL Aurangabad unconditionally.

NESPAL Aurangabad shall be free to take any action, including legal action that the NESPAL Aurangabad may consider necessary to protect their rights under this agreement.

If either party does not act according to enactments of agreement, the aggrieved party will first try to decide the disputes mutually and amicably, failing this, the dispute shall be referred to arbitration according to enactments of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. If, the arbitrator at Aurangabad does not decide or make award on referred point, then the concerned parties may adjudged the disputes by resorting to appropriate legal proceedings under the jurisdiction of Aurangabad.

Govt. College of Engineering, Amravati having its official address at **Kathora Naka, Amravati – 444604** affiliated to **Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati** University (hereinafter referred to as **GCOEA** which expression shall include its representatives, successors and assignees).

Whereas

Whereas IT-ITeS Sector Skills Council NASSCOM (SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM) is an integral part of NASSCOM, the skill standard setting body of the IT-ITeS Industry and is the education & skill development initiative of NASSCOM; SSC NASSCOM works with its industry members and select academic and skill development institutions to help improve the quality and quantity of the employable workforce available to this industry;


The Project here is the "Foundation Skills in Integrated Product Development"(FSIPD) Program, which is a part of The "Engineering Proficiency Program" (EPP) for scaling quality capacity.

GCOEA and **SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM** will herein be referred to as 'Party', and together referred to as 'Parties'.

THE MoU WITNESSED AND THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objective of the MoU

To introduce the Foundation Skills in Integrated Product Development (FSIPD) in the university / college through SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM in the first phase, and subsequently, other modules that are a part of the EPP Program in the second phase, by SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM and its member companies.

2. Period of MoU

This MoU shall come into force on ~~23~~ **10.2013** and will be valid for **3 years** and is open to mutual revision and renewal, annually.

3. Scope of Work

- Universities and colleges agree to collaborate with, and support SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM in the overall design and development of FSIPD and other modules of EPP Programs (as mentioned) in select areas of mutual interest to enhance student employability.
- The programs thus developed shall be used by the college to train students to enhance their skills.

4. Responsibility of SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM

- SSC NASSCOM, through the member companies constituting the Engineering Skill development Council (referred to as the 'Council'), shall facilitate the design and development of add-on program called Foundation Skills in Integrated Product Development (FSIPD), both curricula and content. Each of the modules for the FSIPD program shall be developed by Council members. The IP for the program content lie with SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM.
- SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM shall have the right to review and audit the conduct of training sessions, primarily for feedback on the quality of training sessions, and alteration to program design, and also to track the number of students undergoing the program.
- FSIPD structure in its delivery model, may scope multiple modes of content dissemination, not limited to hard copy, digital content, e-content etc.
- SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM shall conduct 'Train-the-Trainer' programs for colleges involved in the pilot project for the FSIPD Program. The faculty thus trained shall then train students on the FSIPD program, starting January 2014.

5. Responsibility of GCOEA

- GCOEA shall contribute to the design and development of add-on program called FSIPD, wherever possible, and shall mobilize trainers to undergo the 'Train-The-Trainer' program for its faculty.
- GCOEA shall facilitate teaching-learning support for pursuance of the said courses to enhance student employability.
- GCOEA shall facilitate the assessment of students having undergone the said course(s), as suggested by SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM and its Council members, to measure the skill gaps, both pre and post training given to students under various program(s).
- The college shall not use the course material shared with any other third party, except for its intended use, as defined above.
- GCOEA along with the Engineering Skill Development Council members will have the right to review and audit the conduct and content of training session primarily for feedback on the quality of training sessions, and alteration to program design purposes and also to track the number of students undergoing the program. The scope of this project shall be further expandable to other such programs offered / to be offered under SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM.

The contents of this MOU shall be governed by the laws of India and that any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussions held between the senior officials designated respectively by the Parties.
