In the institute many more students are registered for NPTEL courses (Ref.1 NPTEL Policy), to decide the modality for calculation of NPTEL registered student marks, the committee has been set at institute level (Ref. 2). As per the report submitted by committee, the following procedure/steps shall be proposed to calculate the MSE, TA, & ESE Marks of NPTEL Course registered students. All the departments should follow this circular for NPTEL Course Evaluation.

Steps to calculate the MSE, TA, & ESE Marks of NPTEL Course registered students are as per below.

For students who passed in NPTEL online examinations

Step 1: -

$$\text{Internal Marks (out of 40)} = \frac{\text{Online Assignments Score out of 25 (From NPTEL Certificate)}}{25} \times 40$$

- Rounded to lower integer if fraction is < 0.5
- Rounded to upper integer if fraction is ≥ 0.5

Step 2:-

MSE Score = Internal marks (from step 1) X 0.75 ----- Only integer part to consider

TA Score = Internal marks (from step 1) – MSE Score (calculated above in step 2)

Step 3:-

$$\text{ESE Score} = \frac{\text{Proctored exam marks Out of 75 (from NPTEL Certificate)}}{75} \times 60$$

- Rounded to lower integer if Fraction is < 0.5
- Rounded to upper integer if Fraction is ≥ 0.5

Course coordinator should enter MSE, TA & ESE marks in MIS through his/her login.

For students who failed in NPTEL online examinations but completed assignment

- MSE & TA marks should be entered by course coordinator in coordination with NPTEL Dept. coordinator (to be calculated using above step 1 and 2) & ESE score should be entered as "00"
- Assignment scores for such candidate need to be calculated using best 8 assignment scores out of 12 assignment scores for 12week course.
- Such students shall appear for ESE conducted by the Institute and ESE mark of such students shall be entered by CAC after the evaluation of answer sheets.

For Students who failed in NPTEL online examination and not submitted the assignments

- The students who enroll for some NPTEL Course for program Elective VI but could not submit assignments as well as could not appear for final exam will be considered as the NPTEL drop out and will be treated at par with the students enrolled for off line mode and such students will have to appear for MSE, TA, and ESE for the course offered by the respective department as per the conventional procedure, by following the time table of and ESE displayed by the institute. (Refer NPTEL circular no. GCOEA/Dean Acad./2024/549 Date 23/01/2024)

For all kind of NPTEL appeared students discussed above, Grade calculations will be as per Institute rules & regulations.
