The Network Quest Quiz Competition featured three engaging rounds, as participants tested their knowledge on generations of network from 1G to 5G. This contest took place in ET10 class room of the Electronics and Telecommunication department at 3:00 pm. The event was attended by the Students from 2nd to 4th year of Electronics and Telecommunication department. Total 17 pairs participated. The competition was meticulously organized by Overall Convenor Mihir Jaiswal, Overall Co-Convenor Sakshi Sinha, Convenor Yash Randive and Co-Convenor Sharvari Sawarkar and ETAS committee members.
