General Format

• Font: Times New Roman (TNR)

• Font Size: 12

Spacing: 1.5 line spacingPage Size: A4 (both sides)

• Margins:

Top: 1 inch
Left: 1 inch
Right: 1 inch
Bottom: 1 inch
Gutter: 1 inch

• **Indentation**: 0.5 inch

• **Header**: 8 pt italics, chapter name, right-justified (excluding the first page of chapters)

• Footer: Page number, center-justified

Equations

- Equations should be numbered serially in circular brackets.
 - o Example:

$$(x+a)^n = \sum_{k=0}^n \binom{n}{k} x^k a^{n-k}$$

Diagrams and Figures

- All diagrams must be high-quality and clearly legible.
- Captions for figures should be placed below the figure, while table captions should be at the top.
 - o Example:
 - **Table 1.1**: Title of the Table
 - **Figure 2.3**: Title of the Figure

Binding

• Use hard binding, you may print the contents on both sides of the page.

Length

• The total number of pages should be between 25 and 35.

Numbering of Sections

- Main topics should be numbered as 1.1, 1.2, etc.
- Subtopics should be numbered as 1.1.1, 1.1.2, etc.
- All numbered sections must be included in the contents.

References/Bibliography

- References must be properly cited at the end of the report without chapter numbers.
- Use a consistent citation style (e.g., APA, IEEE) and ensure all sources are credible.

Courtesy and Originality

- Always give credit to the original authors of the works you reference.
- Plagiarism will not be tolerated; ensure that all work is original and properly cited.

 - Complete report
 - o Details with programming codes, if any
 - Required software accessories
 - o Name, roll number, mobile number, and email ID of the group members
