**Minutes of meeting of Building and Works Committee held on 22/02/2018
at 9.30 a.m. in meeting hall**

Sixteenth emergent meeting of Building & Works Committee was held on 22/02/2018 at 9.30 a.m. in meeting hall of Govt. College of Engineering, Amravati and following members were present.

At the outset, the Member secretary welcomed all Hon'ble Members of Building & Works Committee.

Item No. 103: To approve the budget for construction of new buildings for Mechanical and Electrical Engineering department

Dr. S.P. Tatewar initiated the agenda and pointed out that the structural audit report mentioned that the Mechanical and Electrical department building are required to be demolished. As per the plan of new buildings, the proposed construction area of each new Mechanical and Electrical Engineering department are 3133.528 square meter. The estimated cost for construction of each building is Rs.1320.48 lakhs. The total estimated cost for two building is Rs. 2640.96 lakhs. Dr. A.I. Dhatarak insisted the need of immediate construction of building on the same place due to emergency. Dr. Dalu, Principal pointed out that Government has asked for some contribution from institute side for construction of building vide letter no.1018/(ptr kr. 9/18)/tashi -3 dated. 22/01/2018. Dr. Ali proposed that about 15%

cost of construction is to be contributed from institute side and it is unanimously decided to propose 15% cost of construction (Rs. 396.144 lakhs for two buildings) to be contributed from institute funds vide letter no.1018/(ptr kr. 9/18)/tashi -3 dated. 22/01/2018. Dr. M.L. Gulhane mentioned the objections raised by Government in the proposal submitted by the college for funding and administrative approval and discussed the compliance to be given. The committee approved the compliance to be given and budget for construction of new buildings for Mechanical and Electrical Engineering department.

Item No.104 : To discuss and recommend the various additional Civil works undertaken after the last meeting of BWC (Not sanctioned earlier)

Dr. Dhatarak pointed out that the old windows of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering department are used in Jijao hostel. Dr. Gulhane has suggested that the rate analysis sheet is to be included in agenda. The committee accepted the suggestion. The committee has given the post facto sanction for the followings works undertaken.

Prof. Mrs. Londhe pointed out that work of chain link with MS angle frame work has been carried out with hostel funds due to emergency and requested to reimburse the expenditure from BWC budget. Dr. Dalu asked to submit the application accordingly so that the expenditure can be reimbursed from BWC fund. Dr. Dalu further suggested to enclose the copy of requirement letters of each work with agenda of BWC. The committee suggested the suggestion given by Hon. Members.

Any other point with the permission of the chair


